Sub: Study Tour Program Of the Bangladesh Public Service Commission (BPSC) officials to Germany.

With reference to the above, this is to inform that a five (05) members team of the Bangladesh Public Service Commission consisting of (1) Quomaran Nessa Khanam, Member, BPSC (Former Secretary to the Government of Bangladesh), (2) Mr. G.M. Mostafa, System Analyst, BPSC Secretariat, (3) Dr. SK. Musliima Moon. Deputy Director, BPSC Secretariat, (4) Mr. Mohammad Ashraful Islam, Deputy Director, BPSC Secretariat and (5) Ms.Umma Asma Aysha, Deputy Director, BPSC Secretariat will visit Germany on a study tour during 12-16 January 2018 or nearby available dates. - o review the organizational structure;
- o learn about the latest initiatives/reforms of PSC/similar organization of Germany regarding appointment policy.


03. BPSC Secretariat seeks to avail the co-operation of the Embassy of Bangladesh in Germany in the following ways:

- o to arrange meetings with the Chairman and officials of the PSC or/and similar organizations.
- o to arrange accommodation and transportation for the team members.
- o to arrange other programs as it deems fit in achieving the objectives of the tour program.

04. In view of the above, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs is requested to kindly advise the Embassy of Bangladesh in Germany to arrange the study tour program, providing necessary logistic support to the team members during their visit and taking necessary action for visas of the team members.
