

Binoy Krishna Bala BPM,PPM



Binoy Krishna Bala BPM,PPM joined as the Member of Bangladesh Public Service Commission (BPSC) on 07 January 2020. Prior to his appointment, he was an Additional Inspector General of Bangladesh Police.

He was born in Gopalganj. He did his Master Degree with Honors from the University of Dhaka in Accounting and later an LLB degree from the National University. Notable, in HSC he stood 4<sup>th</sup> in Dhaka Board in Commerce Group from Nazrul College, Satpar, Gopalganj in the year 1975.

He started his career as an Assistant Superintendent of Police on 15 February 1988 through 7<sup>th</sup> BCS of 1985. Since then he served at home and abroad in many important capacities including Superintendant of Police Barisal District before raising Barisal Metropolitan Police and Kishoreganj District during a critical time of Parliament elections in 2001. He was Additional DIG, Central Crime of CID, Deputy Inspector General (DIG) of Barisal range and the first DIG of Rangpur Range when the new division was established. At Police Headquarters he performed the responsibility of DIG Administration from November 2012 to February 2017, a long period full of different types of challenges.

He was promoted to the rank of Additional Inspector General in 2017 and given the charge of Police Telecom and Information Management (T&IM). During his tenure an operational activity of T&IM “The National Emergency Service 999” was inaugurated on 12 December 2017 by Mr. Sajeeb Wazed Adviser to the Honorable Prime Minister of ICT Affairs who was also its initiator.

He served in the UN Peace Keeping Missions for two and a half years. In the United Nations Protection Force (UNPROFOR) in former Yugoslavia he contributed maintaining peace serving through Operations wing at CIVPOL Headquarters. In United Nations African Mission in Darfur (UNAMID) he was Police Chief of Human Rights at CIVPOL Headquarters and Contingent Commander of 1<sup>st</sup> Bangladesh Police Contingent. Under his leadership Bangladesh police contingent demonstrated a praiseworthy service which led succeeding peace keepers of Bangladesh to serve the mission with honour and dignity.

He joined Heads of INTERPOL Conference in Lyon, France, Participated Seminar on Security in Jinan, China, Symposium on Security of Critical Infrastructure in Miami, USA arranged by INTERPOL and FBI, Senior Mission Leadership Course in Centrul, Indonesia by UNDPKO, Course on Professional Standard and Official Responsibility at Police Staff College by US Department of Justice, ICITAP and Senior Crisis Management Seminar in Washington DC by US State Department.

In his Police career he was given UN Peace Medal twice and awarded Bangladesh Police Medal (BPM) for outstanding service to the people and President Police Medal (PPM) for unparalleled bravery in police operations for crime control. He also achieved IGP's Exemplary Good Services Badge.

He was involved in different organizations, such as Secretary of Police Officers Mess, President of Police Cricket Club, President of Police Volley ball Sub Committee, Councilor of Bangladesh Cricket Board, Member of Officers Club, Dhaka, Member of Police Officers Club, Dhaka, Member of BCS 1985 forum, Life Member of Dhaka University Alumnae Association, Life Member of Dhaka University Accounting Alumnae Association and Member of the Executive Committee of Police service Association. He was also a member/user member of Mymensingh Club, Chattogram Club, Khulna Club, Barisal Club, Rangpur Club and Naogaon Tennis Club.

In different stages of life he was innovated in organizing and playing football, cricket, volleyball, tennis, badminton etc. In addition to that he took part in many cultural activities. In his student life he participated in National TV Debate Competition.

He was awarded Bangabandhu Gold Medal by Bangabandhu Research Foundation and Shere Bangla Gold Medal, Mother Teresa International Gold Crest, Independence Academy Award, Editors Club Award by concerned organizations for pro-people activities.

In his official capacities he visited many countries, such as France, USA, China, South Korea, Indonesia, Malaysia, Serbia, Croatia, Slovenia, Kosovo, Netherland, Germany, Sudan.

He is married to Mrs. Gita Rani Sarker a Master Degree holder with Honors in Political Science from the University of Dhaka. They are blessed with two daughters and a son.
